Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current revision of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), its Prescriptions, the Sailing Instructions and a boat's specific class rules.

Eligibility

The regatta is open to all PHRF boats, Catalina 22s, US Sailing Portsmouth Rated Multihulls and all class-legal One-Design boats. Entrants shall complete registration forms prior to racing. Class breakdowns will be determined by the total number of boats registered. Novice sailors are encouraged to sail in the Cruiser Fleet. A PHRF handicap will be provided for Cruiser Fleet entrants that do not have a certificate.

Registration

Registration may also be accomplished by completing the registration form available on the FWYC website or club bulletin board and either mailing it to FWYC or dropping in the Fleet Captain's box in the FWYC office. Registrants may also bring a completed registration form to the Registration Desk on Saturday, June 12. Online registration is available on the FWYC website (www.fwyc.org).

Fleets

Expected fleets are: A Fleet, B Fleet, C Fleet, Cruiser Fleet, Catalina 22 (C22), Multihull, J-22, and Viper 640.

Racing Area

The racing area will be located in Choctawhatchee Bay, east of FWYC.

Courses & Marks

A, B, C, C22, J22 & V640 Fleets:

The courses will be windward/leeward courses utilizing orange, yellow and lime tetrahedrons and orange balls.

Multihull and Cruiser Fleets:

The courses will be distance courses utilizing government and/or club marks.

Scoring

The Low-Point scoring system, rule A2, will apply.

A, B, C, C22, J22 & V640 Fleets:

If five or more races are sailed, there will be one throw-out.

Two races will constitute a series.

Multihull and Cruiser Fleets:

One race will constitute a series.
