



## NOTICE OF RACE

# ZEVIN MEMORIAL REGATTA



**December 10, 2011 – April 1, 2012**

### 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all PHRF rated boats.
- 2.2 Boats without a valid certificate will be assigned a rating.
- 2.3 PHRF fleets: A (less than 150), B (150 to 199), and C (200 and above).
- 2.4 A minimum of three (3) boats is required to constitute a fleet.
- 2.5 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and remitting the required fee.

### 3. FEES

The entry fee is \$50.00 for the entire series or \$15.00 per race.

### 4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 The regatta consists of five (5) scheduled races to be held on the following dates:  
2011: December 10. 2012: January 22, February 12, March 4, and April 1.
- 4.2 The following schedule applies for each race date:  
11:00 AM – 12:00 PM      Registration  
12:05 PM                      Skippers Meeting  
12:55 PM                      First Warning

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the club bulletin board and at registration on each race date.

### 6. THE COURSES

- 6.1 Courses will be available at the Skippers Meeting before each race.

### 7. SCORING

- 7.1 The High Point System of Addendum A will apply. This changes rules A4.1, A4.2, and A9.
- 7.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.3 No race scores will be excluded. This changes rule A2.

### 8. PRIZES

- 8.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top three (3) boats in each fleet. Awards may be reduced if less than 5 boats are entered in a fleet.
- 8.2 Each boat must compete in at least 60 percent of all completed races to qualify for a series award.
- 8.3 The Awards Ceremony will take place as soon as possible after the last race of the regatta.

### 9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Fort Walton Yacht Club will not accept any responsibility for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with the regatta.

# ADDENDUM

## HIGH POINT SCORING SYSTEM

### 1. RACE SCORES

- 1.1 Define 'N' to be the number of boats that come to the starting area in a particular race. Each boat starting and finishing and not thereafter retiring, being penalized or given redress will be scored as follows:

<u>Finishing Place</u>	<u>Score</u>
First	N
Second	N - 1
Third	N - 2
Fourth	N - 3
Each place thereafter	Subtract 1 additional point

- 1.2 Boats that do not compete in a race will not be scored.  
1.3 Boats that are disqualified will score zero (0) points.  
1.4 All other boats that come into the start area will score one (1) point.

### 2. SERIES SCORES

- 2.1 The series score for each boat will be the sum of her individual race scores.  
2.2 Any excluded race counts as a race to qualify a boat for a series score, but not as one of her scored races.  
2.3 The qualified boat with the highest series score is the winner, and others are ranked accordingly.

### 3. TIES AND OTHER RULES

- 3.1 Race ties will be broken using *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) rule A7.  
3.2 Series ties will be broken using RRS rule A8.
