Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current revision of the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), its Prescriptions and the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility

The regatta is open to ALL boats, provided each boat is double handed.

A PHRF handicap will be provided for entrants that do not have a certificate. Entrants shall complete registration forms during registration prior to racing.

Classes

Classes will be determined by the total number of boats registered. A minimum of two boats will be required to make a class. Expected classes are: A Fleet, B Fleet C Fleet, Catalina 22 and Multihull.

Class Flags

~~———— A Fleet & Multihull — Pink~~

~~———— B Fleet — Green~~

~~———— C Fleet — Purple~~

~~———— Catalina 22 — Yellow~~

A single Class Flag will be used to signal the start time of the first boat in the Bermuda Start sequence. That flag will be a PINK flag.
